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## Comments on part I:

Please, note that the programs SLO's directly relate to the Domains of the Board of Certification(BOC) exam.

A standard for CAATE accreditation is that a program must have a 70% three year aggregate first time pass rate on the BOC exam. The AT Program's three year aggregate first time past rate is 56%. Twenty-seven graduates took the exam and 15 graduates passed the exam the first time in the past 3 years. The percentage of students who passed the examination regardless of the number of attempts is 78%. (21 students past out of 27 students who attempted the exam).

Program's first time pass rate on Board of Certification (BOC) exam.	Spring 2017  The program's first time pass rate for 2016-2017 was 55% (6 out of 11) students past the exam the first time.	Some strategies need to be implemented in order to increase the students' first time pass rate on BOC exam.	The program provided the students in AT 488 BOC Test Prep the opportunity to take three different BOC exam practice tests.  Also, the faculty made themselves available to students to mentor them in their efforts to improve their performance in the domain areas that they scored low in.	The average student scores per domain area of the practice BOC exams were:    1st Exam   3rd Exam     Domain I: 71.79%   80.35%     Domain II: 72.10 %   72.28%     Domain III: 72.28%   79.42%     Domain IV: 68.94%   63.83% *   Domain V: 54.15%   71.25%    The student's test scores improved in all the domain areas except for Domain IV: Therapeutic Intervention (*).  Few of the students took advantage of the faculty mentor opportunities.  Once the students have taken the BOC exam (Fall 2019) it can be determined if the practice exams had any affect on the first time pass rate.

		The program faculty will discuss other potential strategies for improving the program's BOC first time pass rate to implement in the 2019-2020 academic year.

## Comments on part II:

The undergraduate athletic training program will closed after the 2020 cohort graduates. Curricular and instructional method changes can only be made to the senior level athletic training courses. These courses contain content for related mustly to Domains II, IV and V. The program faculty will discuss and plan changes for these courses. One of these courses contains a large amount of content related to SLO #4, which is being assessed in the 2019-2020 academic year per the programs assessment plan.
