

## Student Survey University-Wide Results

Spring 2017

Academic Advising Council administered a student survey in March, April, and May 2017 to evaluate students' undergraduate advising experiences at CSU-Pueblo. The survey was available electronically with a link in PAWS. There were a total of 619 usable responses. Below are the results for the campus.
