How do I provide proof of
my immunizations?

YOUR (OR YOUR PARENTS) PERSONAL RECORDS

You may have an immunization record at home from your childhood. These come in paper form, sometimes a yellow card. Most parents are given this information when you are vaccinated as a child.

YOUR PREVIOUS HIGH SCHOOL OR UNIVERSITY

It is a state and federal law to provide proof of immunization records to attend public school or a university (42 U.S.C. § 217a). You can call these schools directly for this information, and while they are required to keep records for up to 7 years, many of them keep them for many more than that.

YOUR HOME STATE'S IMMUNIZATION REGISTRY

All states have an immunization registry. You can call your specific state's health department for access to that information. Only you or your parent can request that information. For Colorado residents, you may call: 303.692.2437 or 1.888.611.9918.

MMR TITER

If you have trouble finding your records, you can get a blood test known as an MMR TITER. This test can be done with your physician or through Student Health Services. There is a charge for this test.

MEDICAL AND NON-MEDICAL EXEMPTIONS

All MMR exemption forms must be obtained from the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment and returned to the Wolfpack Wellness Center. COVID exemption forms are available through the website but must be signed by a CSU Pueblo medical professional or another provider.
