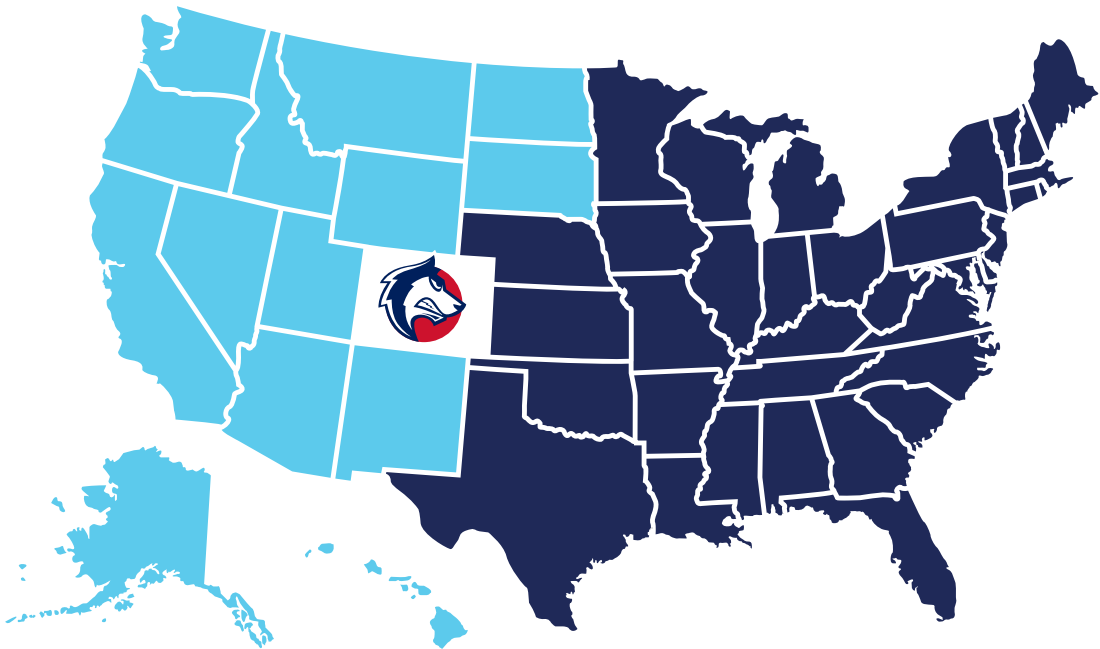
# CSU PUEBLO

- All students, including transfers, are required to live on-campus for their first two years (typically freshman and sophomore) after high school graduation.

CSU Pueblo offers the following scholarships to newly admitted students who meet the minimum academic requirements:

Every student with at least a 3.5 GPA will receive the Emerging Scholar award (\$1,000), regardless of test scores or class rank.

\*Cumulative weighted high school GPA, ACT or SAT composite, and weighted class rank. Students must enroll in the fall semester immediately following their high school graduation.

## ADDITIONAL AUTOMATIC SCHOLARSHIPS

### \$1,000 Commitment to Colorado Award

Colorado residents who complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by March 1 each year, receive a Pell Grant, and have at least a 3.0 GPA.

### \$1,000 First Generation Scholarship

First generation college students (neither parent has received a bachelor's degree), 3.0 high school GPA, FAFSA complete by March 1.

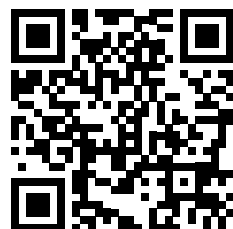

☐ Submit your application at [connect.csupueblo.edu/apply](https://connect.csupueblo.edu/apply)

☐ Submit official transcripts

- Official high school transcripts or high school equivalency test scores.
- If taking college or university classes concurrently with high school courses, submit official college transcripts after completing your last course.\*

☐ Submit official ACT or SAT test scores

- Official test scores are not required for first-time students graduating in 2021 or any student who has earned college credit after graduating high school.
- The writing portion of the exam is not required.

\*Students who complete college courses while enrolled in high school are considered first-year freshmen, regardless of the number of credits earned.

**NOTE:** You will initially be notified of our admission decision on your application status page, usually 2-3 weeks after all required information is received.
