General Education Board, Colorado State University-Pueblo 2014-2015 Administration of the Proficiency Profile, Summary of Results

This document presents key findings from the CSU-Pueblo administration of the ETS Proficiency Profile. The Proficiency Profile was adopted as part of the General Education Board's plan for assessing the general education student learning outcomes.

Administration

The Proficiency Profile was administered to 155 first-time freshmen during the spring 2015 semester. (Students were randomly selected from among all students participating in orientation and assigned to classrooms to participate in the test. Faculty and staff administered the timed, paper-and-pencil exam according to the ETS protocol.)


Working with faculty who agreed to allow members of the General Education Board to administer the test in their upper-level classes, approximately 200 seniors from majors across campus completed the test during the Fall 2014 and Spring 2015 semesters.

At the conclusion of the 2014-2015 academic year, the completed tests were returned to ETS for data analyses.

Results


The following are results for our seniors compared to all masters comprehensive institutions (n=104):

Total mean score for CSU-Pueblo was 444.93 (range 400-500); total mean for all institutions was 447.3 Mean for critical thinking was 111.6 (range 100-130); total mean for all institutions was 112.4 Mean for reading was 118.48 (range 100-130); total mean for all institutions was 118.7 Mean for writing was 114.71 (range 100-130); total mean for all institutions was 114.8 Mean for mathematics was 112.88 (range 100-130); total mean for all institutions was 114.4 Mean for humanities was 114.67 (range 100-130); total mean for all institutions was 115.2 Mean for social sciences was 113.34 (range 100-130); total mean for all institutions was 114.0 Mean for natural sciences 115.57 (range 100-130); total mean for all institutions was 115.9




The following are results for our first-time first year students compared to all masters comprehensive institutions (n=80):

Total mean score for CSU-Pueblo was 437.05; total mean for all institutions was 437.46 Mean for <u>critical thinking</u> was 109.12; total mean for all institutions was 109.92 Mean for reading was 115.66; total mean for all institutions was 115.65 Mean for writing was 112.54; total mean for all institutions was 113.00 Mean for <u>mathematics</u> was 112.52; total mean for all institutions was 111.90 Mean for <u>humanities</u> 111.91; total mean for all institutions was 113.07 Mean for social sciences 110.90; total mean for all institutions was 111.74 Mean for natural sciences 113.84; total mean for all institutions was 113.44
