

How to Find My Financial Aid

Logging into PAWS:

1. From CSU Pueblo website (www.csupueblo.edu), click on Current Students
2. Click on PAWS
3. Log into PAWS
 - a. Students will have the option to log on to PAWS using their NetId Login or their PID. It is strongly preferred that both New and Current students use the NetId login to avoid having to re-authenticate later during the log in process. **You must start your NetID with a “C” followed by your NetID number.**

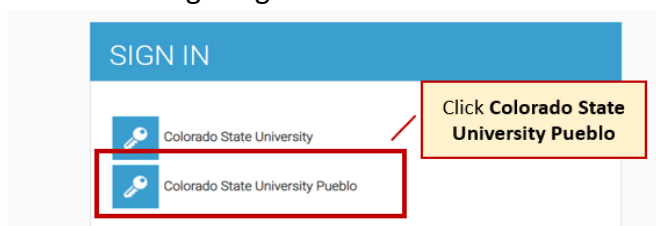

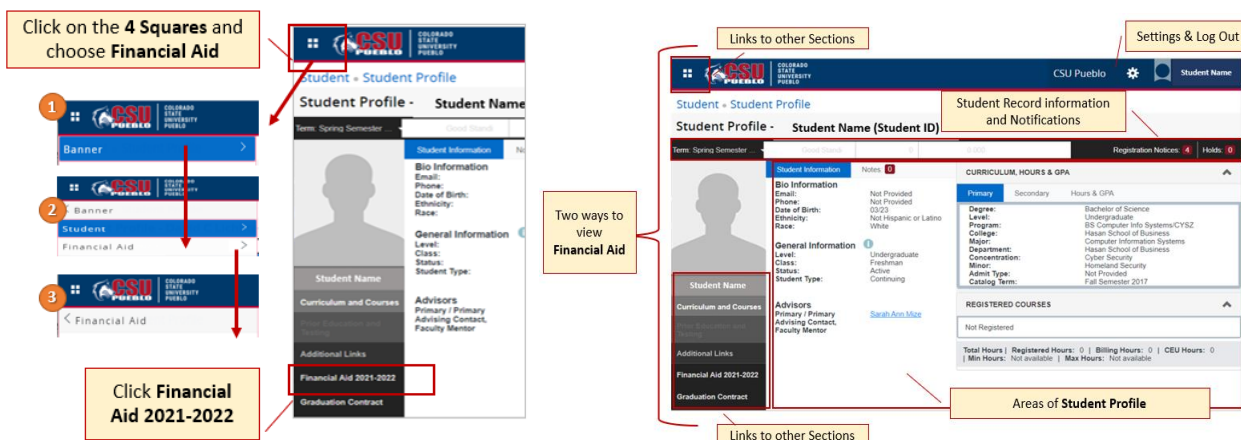
