

COLLEGE OPPORTUNITY FUND (COF)



- What is COF?
 - COF is a stipend provided by the state to be used toward undergraduate tuition at Colorado colleges and universities.
 - Rates are set annually by the Colorado Legislature.
 - The 2023-2024 COF rate is \$116/credit hour.
- All Concurrent Enrollment students are required to register for and authorize their COF stipend.
 Students must respond immediately to requests to address COF errors that prevent funds from being applied against their tuition.
 - COF registration is a one-time process.
 - Lifetime COF authorization is a one-time process, otherwise COF has to be authorized each semester if the Lifetime option is not selected.

- The deadline for COF funds to be applied to a student account is the drop/add date for the term.
 - This means courses added after the drop/add date are not covered by COF funds at \$116/credit hour and become the financial responsibility of the student.
 - Additionally, students who do not address COF errors before the drop/add deadline will be liable to pay that portion of their bill.
