SHIFT-SHARE ANALYSIS:

PUEBLO COUNTY, COLORADO

Introduction

This paper focuses on Shift-Share analysis for Pueblo County. A Shift-Share Analysis is a tool used to measure the shift of the local economy into faster or slower growth sectors and the community's larger or smaller share of the growth occurring in any particular economic sector. The Shift-Share Analysis will also provide information about the sources of job growth in Pueblo County. This Shift-Share Analysis is intended to provide information about the local economy of Pueblo County in terms of growth in job sectors, the concentration and share of these sectors in the County, and the efficiency within these sectors as compared to the nation. The Shift-Share Analysis for Pueblo County, when compared to the nation, will provide a better understanding of the composition and competitiveness of the local economy. Shift-Share Analysis uses three components to show a gain or loss of jobs throughout industries in Pueblo County. These industries include the National Growth component, the Industry Mix component, and the Competitive Share component.

The National Growth Component (NGC) calculates the number of new jobs that were created locally due to national employment trends. In terms of this analysis, the NGC will express how many jobs should have been created in Pueblo County between 2004 and 2005 due to national trends. The NGC assumes the local economy is similar to the nation in order to calculate this component. As a result, the number achieved from the calculation may be over or understated and, therefore, serves as a general estimate for the number of new jobs actually created in the local economy because of national employment trends.

The national growth component is calculated by taking the number of people employed in each industry in Pueblo County in the year 2004 and multiplying it by the national growth rate. Then all of the totals are summed to get a final total which indicates the total amount of jobs that should have been created in Pueblo County due to national trends. To calculate the national growth rate, the total employment in all industries for the nation in 2005 is subtracted from the total employment in all industries for the nation in 2004. The gain or loss of jobs between 2004 and 2005 is then divided by the total employment in 2004 which results in a decimal number that can then be converted into a percentage.

National Growth Component

Local emp. in Industry A in 2004 x National Growth Rate = National Growth Component (# of jobs that should have been created in Industry A due to national trends)

*All industries added together to get final number of new jobs that should have been created in each industry in Pueblo due to national trends

The national employment growth rate between 2004 and 2005 was calculated to be 1.97%. An example of the application of the formula will be used for the industry of Food Manufacturing. In 2004, there were 407 people employed in Food Manufacturing in Pueblo County. Thus, the calculation proceeds as follows:

$$407 \times 1.97\% = 8.0179$$

The preceding equation indicates that that, due to national trends, approximately 8 new jobs should have been created in Pueblo County in the industry of Food Manufacturing between 2004 and 2005. Additionally, this number of new jobs is determined on the assumption that

Pueblo County grew at the national rate. If Pueblo County grew below the national average, it would be expected that this number of new jobs would be less.

The Industry Mix component is used to determine whether the overall composition of the local economy is concentrated in faster or slower growth sectors as compared to the national average. After computing the Industry Mix component for each sector and adding up the totals, an analysis is possible. A positive total indicates that the local economy has more jobs in faster growth sectors, whereas a negative total indicates that the local economy has a heavy concentration in slower growth sectors.

The Industry Mix component is calculated by multiplying the number of people employed in an industry in the base year (2004, in this case) by the difference between the national percentage change in employment for that industry and the overall total national employment change between 2004 and 2005. The result indicates the Industry Mix component for that industry. After this has been calculated for all industries, the sum of all the Industry Mix components is taken, and a total Industry Mix component for the local economy is given.

Industry Mix Component

Local emp. in Industry A in 2004 x (National % change in emp. in Industry A - Total national % change in emp.) = Industry Mix Component

*All industries added together to get final number total Industry Mix number which indicates the number of jobs gained or lost due to the overall concentration of local jobs is in faster or slower growth industries.

Using the national employment growth rate of 1.97%, the Industry Mix component for each industry could then be calculated once the percentage change in employment for each industry was calculated. An illustration of this formula will be presented again using the Food

Manufacturing industry as an example. The percentage change in employment in Food Manufacturing in Pueblo County between 2004 and 2005 was -14.5%, and the percentage change in employment in Food Manufacturing nationally was -0.89%. The equation proceeds as follows:

$$407 X (-0.89\% - [1.97\%]) = -11.65$$

The preceding equation indicates an Industry Mix of -11.65%. This indicates that Food Manufacturing in Pueblo County is a relatively slow growth industry compared to the national standard. In other words, Food Manufacturing is growing slower in Pueblo County than in the rest of nation.

The Competitive Share component indicates the efficiency of the local economy by measuring the ability of the local economy to capture an increasing share of a particular sector's growth. To compute this component for each sector, local employment in each sector in the base year is multiplied by the difference in the national and local sector rates. Once the calculation has been done for each sector, the sum of all the sectors is taken. If the total of the sum is positive, this indicates that the local community is more efficient than the rest of the nation. On the other hand, a total that is less than zero indicates that the sectors in the local economy are relatively inefficient as compared to the rest of the nation in securing employment and, as a result, jobs are lost in the local economy.

Competitive Share Component

Local emp. in Industry A in 2004 x (Local % change in emp. in Industry A - National % change in emp. in Industry A) = Competitive Share Component

^{*}All industries added together to get final number total Competitive Share number which indicates the total number of jobs gained or lost based on the efficiency of local industries.

The following example shows the actual Competitive Share computation for two industries in this study, Crop Production and Agriculture and Forestry Support.

Competitive Share Component

Example: 150(2.00-(-1.22)) = 4.83 Crop Production
04 base Yr X(%change in local employ 04-05-(% change in employ nationally 04-05))

* This industry is more efficient in securing additional employment than the rest of the nation

Example: 9(-11.11-4.23) = -1.38 Agriculture & Forestry support

* This industry is not as efficient in securing additional employment than the rest of the nation

The Competitive Share component for Crop Production is 4.83. Since 4.83 > 0, this indicates that the industry of Crop Production in Pueblo, Colorado is relatively efficient as compared to the national average. On the other hand, the Competitive Share component for Agriculture & Forestry Support is -1.38. Since -1.38 < 0, this indicates that the industry of Agriculture & Forestry Support in Pueblo is relatively inefficient as compared to the national standard for that industry. This would be an industry that would need to be examined to see why it is below the national standard.

Shift-Share Analysis is very useful in indicating job growth, the composition of jobs in the local economy, and the efficiency of local industries. However, Shift-Share Analysis does not fully indicate why and where a change of employment specifically came from or resulted from. It only indicates the level of change in employment as compared to national averages. For instance, a negative competitive share component for one industry might be -4. This indicates that 4 local jobs were lost in this particular industry due to some inefficiency in the operation of that industry locally. However, the Shift-Share Analysis is unable to indicate what that particular

inefficiency is (i.e. old machinery, unskilled labor, etc.). It merely expresses that inefficiency exists and requires further inspection in order to determine the inefficiency itself.

Methodology

In order to conduct this Shift-Share Analysis, employment data was gathered for Pueblo, Colorado as well as the United States as a whole for the years 2004 and 2005. The data was gathered from the Bureau of Labor Statistics. Data was then organized into spreadsheets. The spreadsheets gave a detailed description of each industry in terms of employment in each particular industry in 2004 and 2005 for both Pueblo and the nation, the percentage change in employment between 2004 and 2005 for Pueblo and the nation, and the gain or loss of jobs in each industry for Pueblo and the nation. Equations were used within the spreadsheets in order to calculate the National Growth component, the Industry Mix component, and the Competitive Share component. In addition, totals for each category were calculated in order to be able to draw overall conclusions about the economy of Pueblo County.

It is also necessary to note that data was gathered only for the private sector of Pueblo County. This is because the public sector including government employment was unavailable and, thus, excluded from final calculations and total employment figures.

Results

The aggregate National Growth component for Pueblo County between 2004 and 2005 was 830.9854; following the national employment growth of 1.97% between 2004 and 2005.

This indicates that approximately 831 jobs should have been created in Pueblo County between 2004 and 2005 because of trends in the national economy. The following table illustrates several industries that showed particularly high gains in employment due to the National Growth component.

Some of the industries that indicated a relatively high gain in jobs according to the National Growth component were Food Service and Drinking Places (96.6285 jobs), Ambulatory Health Care Services (66.0147 jobs), Administrative and Support Services (61.3655 jobs), and Specialty Trade Contractors (46.0586 jobs).

The overall Industry Mix component for Pueblo County was 72.95797583 jobs. Thus, approximately 73 local jobs were created due to having employment in the County mainly concentrated in fast growth industries. Since this number is well above zero, it indicates that the composition of jobs in Pueblo County is largely concentrated in faster growth industries. The table below summarizes the higher and lower growth industries within the County.

Based on the results, those industries with a particularly high Industry Mix component include Specialty Trade Contractors (72.95450213 jobs), Ambulatory Care Services

(49.58244874 jobs), Administrative and Support Services (38.33442994 jobs), Food Service and Drinking Places (30.01959908 jobs), and Construction of Buildings (27.05094049 jobs). The relatively high Industry Mix components for these industries indicates not only that they are fast growing industries, but that Pueblo has a significant amount of local jobs within these particular industries. This also greatly contributes to the high total Industry Mix component for the county of Pueblo.

Several of the industries that that had a negative Industry Mix component included Food and Beverage stores (-23.21240901 jobs), Primary Metal Manufacturing (-20.69483461 jobs), Utilities (-15.93400898 jobs), and Telecommunications (-16.34614295 jobs).

The total Competitive Share component for Pueblo County was calculated to be -602.5197951 jobs. This indicates that approximately 603 jobs were lost in Pueblo County between 2004 and 2005. Because the Competitive Share component resulted in a negative number, it can be inferred that 603 jobs were lost due to inefficiencies in the local economy.

Several of the industries that indicated a large loss of jobs for the Competitive Share component included Ambulatory and Health Care Services (-143.5971487 jobs), Professional and Technical Services (-87.98659924 jobs), and Heavy and Civil Engineering Construction (-123.9903104 jobs). The high loss of jobs can be the result of several factors including the use of equipment that is, perhaps, not up-to-date, being behind other industries in the nation as far as methods and techniques, or other inefficiencies that may result from daily operations.

On the other hand, though the aggregate Competitive Share component was negative, there were several industries in Pueblo whose efficiency was greater than the national average. Those industries included Food Service and Drinking Places (139.3519009), Electronic Appliance Stores (20.78343895), Non-metallic Mineral Product Manufacturing (28.38947533), and Amusement/Gambling and Recreation (114.8728005). Due to their high Competitive Share components, these industries in Pueblo have shown a great efficiency in securing employment as compared to the national average for these industries.

When the three components of the shift-share analysis are added together, the total indicates that a total of 301 jobs were created in Pueblo County between 2004 and 2005.

$$NGC + IMC + CSC = Total Number of Jobs Gained/Lost$$

 $831 + 73 + (-603) = 301$

Of the 301 jobs gained between 2004 and 2005, the majority were a result of national economic growth. Since the Industry Mix component was also positive (73 jobs), this indicates that the majority of local employment in Pueblo County is already concentrated in sectors that

are growing fast. However, because the Competitive Share component revealed a loss of 603 jobs in Pueblo County, this is an indication that local businesses and firms are not as efficient and competitive when it comes to securing employment as the national averages.

Conclusion

As previously stated, most of the gains in employment in Pueblo County between 2004 and 2005 were a direct result of employment growth in certain industries, including Food Service and Drinking Places, Ambulatory Health Care Services, Administrative and Support Services, and Specialty Trade Contractors. These can be attributed to national growth economic trends in these industries. Because the Industry Mix component was positive (73 jobs), Pueblo County has a good composition of employment in fast growth industries. To continue to capitalize on this advantage, Pueblo County could encourage further expansion in these fast growth industries, particularly, in Specialty Trade Contractors, Ambulatory Health Care Services, Administrative and Support Services, Food and Drinking Places, and Construction of Buildings.

A substantial loss of jobs were indicated by the Competitive Share component (-603 jobs). This indicates that Pueblo County is losing employment because of some sort of inefficiencies within local industries, particularly, in Ambulatory and Health Care Services, Professional and Technical Services, and Heavy and Civil Engineering Construction.

Subsequently, these industries all indicated a positive Industry Mix component. This is a particular concern for Pueblo County because, although jobs are gained due to a concentration in these fast growth industries, jobs are also lost in these industries due to internal inefficiencies. As a result, Pueblo County should be especially focused on being able to make these industries as competitive as national standards in order to prevent further loss of employment.

The County could encourage these industries in several ways. First, it would be essential to make sure that the industries are using the most up-to-date methods, techniques, and technologies available. Another source of inefficiency could come from unskilled or undertrained employees. These firms could offer more training opportunities for employees as well as providing them the opportunity to attend state or national industry conferences where they would be able to see what their counterparts around the nation are doing and how to better meet national industry standards. Additionally, the County has the luxury of having a local university – Colorado State University-Pueblo. This is a great resource for local firms and businesses to recruit educated workers to help boost their efficiency. Being that the University is local, it is easier and less expensive to recruit employees with a college degree. In addition, the County might consider encouraging these businesses to offer internships to CSU-Pueblo students as a way of keeping local talent within the County.

As indicated earlier, there were several industries that had a relatively high Competitive Share component. These industries included Food Service and Drinking Places, Electronic Appliance Stores, Non-metallic Mineral Product Manufacturing, and Amusement/Gambling and Recreation. Since the Competitive Share component is relatively high for these industries, this indicates that these local industries are quite efficient, even above national standards. As a result, the County should encourage further growth and expansion in these industries because of their apparent competitive advantages, and these could be a source of further employment gains for Pueblo County. Encouraging local banks to provide loans for these industries to further progress and become more efficient could be a beneficial policy for Pueblo County to consider advocating.


