Emergency Text Messaging (Employee Form)

In situations involving life and safety, Colorado State University-Pueblo has established an Emergency Notification System that will send a text message to your cell phone. Other than emergencies and a bi-annual system test (approximately once per semester), this cell phone number will not be used for any other purposes.

It may take up to 72 hours for your cell phone number to become active in the Emergency Notification System. Your cellular service provider's standard rates for receiving text messages may apply.

Please note: Carriers often block text messages for new numbers, ported numbers, and billing issues. If you have verified the number below is correct and you do not receive the bi-annual test message, you will need to check with your carrier to insure that your number is not deactivated from receiving subscription text messaging from short codes.
