All work-related accidents and illnesses must be reported without delay to the immediate supervisor. The injured employee and his/her supervisor must complete the necessary forms in Human Resources, Admin. 306, no later than four (4) working days after the accident. The Human Resources Office will contact the clinic selected by the employee.

In the event of a life or limb-threatening emergency, the injured employee will be transported to the nearest emergency medical facility. **However, follow-up care must be provided by one of the facilities noted above.**

If an employee is treated by any medical provider other than the designated provider, the employee will be responsible for payment of such treatment.

NOTE: Individuals who sustain an injury on campus and are not employed by the university must seek benefits from their personal insurance carrier.
