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Overview

The University Library is situated at the literal and figurative center of the CSU Pueblo campus. It anchors the LARC (Library and Academic Resourced Center) which was the first building on campus and was completely renovated and expanded in 2011, with further updates in 2023.

The University Library, with a team of 16 full- and part-faculty and staff members plus 40 student employees, provides a wide variety of collections, technology, and workspaces in a collaborative academic environment.

The Colorado State University Pueblo Library supports the university's mission by teaching students to identify, evaluate, and utilize information resources; providing collections, spaces, and services in a collaborative academic environment; and encouraging research and intellectual curiosity through campus and community engagement.

ENSURE THAT STUDENTS CAN IDENTIFY, EVALUATE, AND UTILIZE INFORMATION RESOURCES.

Objective 1:

Enhance librarian engagement with faculty to provide coordinated instruction across the curriculum that ensures students can identify, evaluate, and use information resources.

By May 2026, directly contact faculty members via email, phone, or department visit 25 times.





ENSURE THAT STUDENTS CAN IDENTIFY, EVALUATE, AND UTILIZE INFORMATION RESOURCES.

Objective 2:

Contribute to first- and second-year student retention by increasing the number of those students who receive library research instruction and reference support.

By May 2026, increase the number of 100- and 200-level classes that receive instruction from a librarian from 1070 to 1350.

By May 2026, increase number of reference transactions including chats, emails, phone calls, and in-person questions from 1180 to 1400.







PROVIDE COLLECTIONS, SPACES, AND SERVICES IN A COLLABORATIVE ACADEMIC ENVIRONMENT.

Objective 1:

Expand LINC services by incorporating the Library first floor more fully into LINC operations, cross-training students on both floors, and expanding services

By November 2025, 90% of fall cohort students complete the training checklist.

Incorporate student feedback into spring student training.







Objective 2:

Optimize the Library's physical collections by discarding materials.

By December 2025 develop the criteria that will be used to deselect materials and obtain analytics reports.





GOAL #2

PROVIDE COLLECTIONS, SPACES, AND SERVICES IN A COLLABORATIVE ACADEMIC ENVIRONMENT.

Objective 3:

Increase faculty and graduate student knowledge of scholarly communications principles by offering targeted workshops

By April 2026, offer 4 workshops.

80% of attendees will indicate that the workshop helped them increase their knowledge of scholarly communications principles.



Engage campus and community to support intellectual curiosity and research.

Objective 1:

Grow and support the annual Aztlán Research Center Summer Institute.

By July 29, 2025, 200 attendees will register for the summer institute and 90% of those who respond to a satisfaction survey will express overall satisfaction.





Engage campus and community to support intellectual curiosity and research.

Objective 2:

Publish Library newsletter promoting library collections, spaces, and services and highlighting educational and entertainment events open to the campus and community.

By May 2026, >80% of recipients open the newsletter and 2% of those who read the newsletter complete the feedback survey.





Engage campus and community to support intellectual curiosity and research.

Objective 3:


Launch CCMA (Colorado Chicano Movement Archives) podcast: *Chicano Legacies* .


By June 30, 2026, release at least 3 podcast episodes.
