



DR. PATRICK K. CARNEY has served as the Associate Professor of Music Education and Director of Instrumental Music at Limestone College in Gaffney, South Carolina since 2014. His responsibilities include directing the LC Wind Ensemble, teaching the instrumental conducting sequence, coordinating all aspects of Limestone's comprehensive instrumental program and teaching the music education curriculum for all music education majors. Prior to his appointment at LC, he

served as Director of Bands at the following universities: Montana State, Clayton State, Charleston Southern, and Claflin; as well as serving as Director of Athletic Bands at the University of Oregon.

An active guest conductor, clinician, and adjudicator, Dr. Carney has served in these capacities throughout the United States and Southeast Asia. He has conducted wind bands nationally in California, Florida, Georgia, Montana, New York, Ohio, Oregon, South Carolina, and Virginia; and internationally in Singapore, Thailand, and Vietnam.

His publications have appeared in *Research Perspectives in Music Education*, *Florida Music Director*, *The Instrumentalist*, and *the Missouri Journal of Research in Music Education*. Dr. Carney has presented his research at conferences for College Band Directors National Association (CBDNA), National Band Association (NBA), National Association of Music Educators (NAfME), and the state Music Educators Association Conferences of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, South Carolina and Tennessee.

Dr. Carney is an active member of CBDNA, NAfME, NBA, the South Carolina Music Educators Association (SCMEA), the Florida Music Educators Association (FMEA), the Florida Bandmasters Association (FBA) and the South Carolina Band Directors Association (SCBDA). Dr. Carney currently serves as Chair of the Small College Committee for CBDNA and Chairman of the SCMEA Collegiate Membership. He has served as the Montana State Chair for the NBA and Co-Governor of both the Western and Midwest Districts of Kappa Kappa Psi. Dr. Carney is an honorary of Kappa Kappa Psi and Tau Beta Sigma, as well as a member of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia.

Dr. Carney earned his Bachelor of Music and Master of Music Theory from The Florida State University, a Master of Music Education from Syracuse University, and a Ph.D. in Music Education from The Florida State University. He is a native of Winter Haven, Florida, and currently lives in Gaffney, SC with his beautiful wife, Jennifer, and wonderful daughter, Emma.
