Please note: Application to the nursing program is a 2-part process:

- 1. All applicants: Must submit an application and be accepted to CSU Pueblo with a personal identification number (NET ID) before applying to the School of Nursing. If you are currently a CSU Pueblo student applying for the Basic Nursing BSN you do not need to complete this step. If you are a current CSU Pueblo student who is applying for the accelerated BSN you will apply for a second degree and state BSN as the major for the second degree AFTER your first undergraduate degree is awarded by the university and can be seen on the transcript. If you are not a current CSU Pueblo student please apply to the university BEFORE applying to the nursing program.
- **2. All applicants:** *Must* submit an application to the <u>School of Nursing</u> by the **deadline** *before being considered for acceptance into the program.*
 - Basic Applicants: Submit application to the <u>School of Nursing</u> before May 25th of the year preceding January admission.
 - Accelerated applicants: Submit application to the <u>School of Nursing</u> before October 1st of the year preceding May admission.
