**Please note: Application to the nursing program is a 2-part process:**

1. **All applicants:** *Must* submit an application and be accepted to CSU Pueblo with a personal identification number (NET ID) *before* applying to the School of Nursing. If you are currently a CSU Pueblo student applying for the Basic Nursing BSN you do not need to complete this step. If you are a current CSU Pueblo student who is applying for the accelerated BSN you will apply for a second degree and state BSN as the major for the second degree **AFTER** your first undergraduate degree is awarded by the university and can be seen on the transcript. If you are not a current CSU Pueblo student please apply to the university **BEFORE** applying to the nursing program.
2. **All applicants:** *Must* submit an application to the School of Nursing by the **deadline** *before being considered for acceptance into the program*.
  - **Basic Applicants:** Submit application to the School of Nursing **before May 25<sup>th</sup>** of the year preceding January admission.
  - **Accelerated applicants:** Submit application to the School of Nursing **before October 1<sup>st</sup>** of the year preceding May admission.
