

AY 24- 25 Student Tuition & Fee Exemptions and Explanations

The following outlines the various student populations that have varying fee structures that are different from Residential Instruction (RI) students. The acronyms throughout this document are student or section level attributes in Banner to differentiate the various student and section types.

- **CSU Pueblo Online**: Students enrolled in only CSU Pueblo Online sections (XONL), non-RI sections, are exempt from all mandatory fees, recreation center fees, and technology fees. Tuition is listed at a flat tuition rate at the section level, regardless of residency. If a student takes at least 1 RI credit hour, students are charged mandatory fees, recreation center fees, and technology fees for the number of credit hours in which they are enrolled.
- **Residential Instruction Off Campus**: Students are enrolled in sections located at the following locations (RIOC attributes) are charged RI tuition rates and pay only the technology fee:
 - CSU Pueblo at Spanish Peaks (HUER)
 - CSU Pueblo at Pikes Peak (PPSC)
 - CSU Pueblo at Fort Carson (MSFC)
 - CSU Pueblo at Sturm Collaboration Campus (SCC)
 - CSU Pueblo at Youthful Offender Systems (XDOC)
- **Tuition Assistance**: Students who are verified as active-duty military qualify for in-state tuition at \$250.00 per credit hour. Students pay full fees associated with their credit hours enrolled.
- Independent Study Programs: Students enrolled in Independent Study Program sections (XD) are exempt from all mandatory fees, recreation center fees, and technology fees. Tuition is listed at a flat tuition rate at the section level, regardless of residency.
- **Non-credit Coursework**: Students enrolled in any CNED sections, which are listed as noncredit coursework) are exempt from all mandatory fees, recreation center fees, and technology fees.
- **Concurrent Enrollment**: Students whose program code is concurrent enrollment (CONC-UG) are charged the Concurrent Enrollment tuition rate and 25% of mandatory fees, recreation center fees, and technology fees.
 - Concurrent enrollment includes ASCENT (ASAS) and TREP (TREP) students, and the student's program code will be CONC-UG.
- Senior to Sophomore Students: Students enrolled in senior-to-sophomore sections (XSTS) at high schools throughout the state of Colorado are exempt from all mandatory fees, recreation center fees, and technology fees.
- **Teacher Education Program Students**: Students enrolled in Teacher Education Program sections (XTEP) through third-party education providers for professional development and the Master of Education program are exempt from all mandatory fees, recreation center fees, and technology fees.
