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Getting Started

Who is an "adult learner"?

Adult learners are non-traditional students with a diverse range of backgrounds, responsibilities, and experiences. Typically over the age of 25, most adult learners are seeking education to either assist with a career change, advance economically, or move up in their profession.

Because adult learners often have commitments outside of school, such as work or family responsibilities, they need the flexibility to create their own schedules and meet with advisors outside of regular office hours. Adult learners may study part-time by taking only a couple courses per term.

The Division of Extended Studies at CSU Pueblo offers a variety of programs specifically designed with adult learners in mind. We offer a unique combination of flexibility, quality, and affordability that is hard to beat.

Prior Learning Assessment

Overview

Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) allows students to earn college credits for what they already know. This means students could spend less money in tuition and graduate faster! PLA is experience-based learning outside of the college and university setting. It includes learning from work and life experiences. Students who gain credit from these specialized experiences, skills, and knowledge can apply the earned credit toward the programs in this handbook.

Benefits

Students with 12 or more PLA credits save an estimated 9-14 months of time spent earning degree. Depending on their program, students save an estimated \$1,500 to \$10,200 from PLA.

How to Earn Credit

One way to obtain credit is by portfolio or demonstration of your learning from a variety of experiences and non-credit activities. Faculty then evaluate your portfolio and award credit if appropriate.

There are multiple other ways to earn credit, including:

- College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) Testing
- Defense Activity for Non-Traditional Education Support (DANTES) Testing
- Challenge Exams
- High School Advanced Placement (AP)
- International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Program
- Military Credit from a Joint Services Transcript (JST)



About CSU Pueblo Online

Our online programs are accredited, affordable, and accessible, making them a great choice for adult learners.

Online - CSU Pueblo Online programs are fully online, and coursework can be completed from anywhere.

Asynchronous - Classes are asynchronous, which is a type of instruction where students learn on their own schedules at a self-paced manner within a certain timeframe.

Open Enrollment - There are six terms per year. Each term is eight weeks long. Students can start at any of these entry points and choose which terms they want to register for.

Application and Admissions Process

- 5. If applicable, complete the transfer evaluation process

Tuition

All online programs are offered at a flat tuition rate, regardless of residency. Undergraduate tuition costs currently range from \$400-\$450 per credit hour depending on program, though subject to change.

Most programs are eligible for financial aid or seasonal scholarships for certificate-seeking or degree-seeking students. Military scholarships are available year-round for qualifying applicants.

Business Management, BSBA

Program Overview

The goal of the Bachelor of Science in Business Management (BSBA) is to provide students with an understanding of the fundamentals of accounting, economics, finance, and the basics of managing a business and marketing a product or service.

Business processes will certainly play a role in the career path of most professionals, regardless of whether their goals are in banking, manufacturing, art, hospitality, or other career fields. Individuals who complete a BSBA degree will develop the knowledge and in-demand skills that can help them maximize an organization's ROI.

Accreditation

This program is in partnership with CSU Pueblo's Hasan School of Business, which is internationally accredited by the Association to Advance the Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB) accreditation. Only 5% of business schools worldwide are AACSB-Accredited, considered by many to be the highest level of accreditation for schools of business. (www.acccsb.edu)

The Bachelor of Applied Science (BAS) in Health Science and Administration is an online 2+2 program. This program bridges Allied Healthcare professionals who hold a two-year degree and current healthcare licensure or certification to earn a Bachelor's degree.

Students will learn communication, technical and administrative skills necessary to enhance their preparation for working in these industries. Choosing a Health Science and Administration degree prepares students for a robust and versatile advanced career in a large interdisciplinary healthcare arena.

About Independent Study

Independent Study at CSU Pueblo provides rigorous, flexible courses and degree programs so that you can achieve your educational goals on your own schedule.

Our Independent Study courses are correspondence courses where students set their own schedule to complete coursework with the guidance and feedback from instructors. Students can register for a course at any time and may have anywhere from 16 weeks to 12 months to complete the course, depending on the payment method. The majority of our courses are offered in both print-based and digital formats, with a few exceptions.

Tuition

Our courses are not only flexible but affordable! Independent Study tuition is a flat rate and is the same regardless of where you live, whether you reside in Colorado or out-of-state. There is a small fee added to print-based tuition to cover printing and mailing costs. Some courses require exam proctoring, and any fees assessed by proctoring services are the responsibility of the student. The cost of textbooks is not included in tuition.

Criminology, BS or BA

Program Overview

Criminology examines the making of laws, the nature and extent of crime and criminality, and efforts to control crime. The Criminology program provides students with a strong foundation in sociological theory and research. This foundation will foster a comprehensive and contextual understanding of crime and justice in society. The program will also teach students to think critically and creatively about what is effective in current crime control efforts. The program is available as a Bachelor of Science (BS) or Bachelor of Arts (BA).

Courses focus on the social construction or definitions of crime, the causes of crime and delinquency, and on the origin, nature, and consequences of societal reactions to criminal offending, including practices in both public and private justice agencies.

Sociology examines human society with an emphasis on social structure, social interaction, and social change. From the analysis of passing encounters between strangers on the street to the investigation of broad-based global social movements, Sociology examines the subtle yet complex ways individual lives interact and intersect with the collective experience of others. One of the Sociology program's special emphases is understanding social inequalities and their implication for social justice. Comparative, cross-national, and cross-cultural perspectives are also offered in many courses. The program is available as a Bachelor of Science (BS) or Bachelor of Arts (BA).
