Degrees - Undergraduate

RN-BSN OL

The Registered Nurse to BSN Online Progam is tailored for working nurses that are looking to complete their Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) Degree.

ELIGIBILITY: Have an RN license or currently enrolled in an ADN program. **TOTAL CREDITS:** 30 **PROGRAM LENGTH:** Average 1 year

Health Science & Administration, BAS oL

The Health Science and Administration, Bachelor of Applied Science bridges professionals who hold a two-year Allied Health degree and a bachelor's degree.

ELIGIBILITY: 2 year degree (AAS, AGS, AS) and a current Allied Healthcare license or certification at the state level. TOTAL CREDITS: 30-60 (depending on transfer hours) PROGRAM LENGTH: Average 1-2 years



Certificates

Students seeking certification who already have a nursing degree are evaluated through gap analysis on an individual basis. Students must fulfill the following requirements to complete a post bachelor's or master's certification.

Post Bachelors Nurse Educator OL

ELIGIBILITY: BSN and current RN license TOTAL CREDITS: 9 PROGRAM LENGTH: 1-2 years

Post Masters Nurse Educator OL

ELIGIBILITY: MSN and current RN license **TOTAL CREDITS:** 13-30 (determined by gap analysis) **PROGRAM LENGTH:** 1-2 years

Adult/Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioner H

ELIGIBILITY: DNP, PHD or MSN, and current RN license **TOTAL CREDITS:** 26-52 (determined by gap analysis) **PROGRAM LENGTH:** 2-2.5 years

Adult/Gerontology Acute Care & Family Nurse Practitioner H

ELIGIBILITY: DNP, PHD or MSN, and current RN license **TOTAL CREDITS:** 47-73 (determined by gap analysis) **PROGRAM LENGTH:** 2-2.5 years

Psychiatric-Mental Health Nurse Practitioner H

ELIGIBILITY: DNP, PHD or MSN, and current RN license **TOTAL CREDITS:** 31-55 (determined by gap analysis) **PROGRAM LENGTH:** 1.5-2.5 years

RN-MS Nurse Educator oL

This program prepares nurses to practice as faculty or staff development educators in universities, hospital-based schools of nursing, technical schools & health care facilities.

ELIGIBILITY: Have an RN license or currently enrolled in an ADN program. Must have Colorado RN license to take graduate-level classes. **TOTAL CREDITS:** 48 **PROGRAM LENGTH:** Average 2 years

Nurse Manager & Leader OL ELIGIBILITY: BSN and Colorado RN license TOTAL CREDITS: 35 PROGRAM LENGTH: 1-2 years

Nurse Educator OL ELIGIBILITY: BSN and Colorado RN license TOTAL CREDITS: 30 PROGRAM LENGTH: 1-2 years

Adult/Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioner H

ELIGIBILITY: BSN and Colorado RN license **TOTAL CREDITS:** 52 **PROGRAM LENGTH:** 2.5 years

Adult/Gerontology Acute Care & Family Nurse Practitioner H

ELIGIBILITY: BSN and Colorado RN license TOTAL CREDITS: 73 PROGRAM LENGTH: 2.5 years

Psychiatric-Mental Health Nurse Practitioner H

ELIGIBILITY: BSN and Colorado RN license TOTAL CREDITS: 55 PROGRAM LENGTH: 2.5 years

Population Health H

ELIGIBILITY: PHD or MSN, and Colorado RN license **TOTAL CREDITS:** 35-39 (determined by gap analysis) **PROGRAM LENGTH:** 5 semesters full-time or 8 semesters part-time

MBA with Healthcare Admnistration Emphasis OL, RI, H

This program prepares students for high-level management careers in the health care field. Students will learn a wide variety of management, healthcare function, business and behavior skills.

ELIGIBILITY: Bachelor's degree TOTAL CREDITS: 36 PROGRAM LENGTH: 1-2 years
