STUDENT EXCLUSIONS BY STATUS or MAJOR PROGRAM

The following students will be excluded from the Bookstore per credit charges to Undergraduate degree-seeking students:

Non-degree Seeking students (but keep concurrent enrollment = CONC majors)

(specific student groups with alternative educational structure and technology access)

Incarcerated students (Extended studies provision of text materials in alternative educational structure to fit technology access challenges)

All Graduate students (Masters and Doctorate programs)

All Nursing BSN Students- This includes the following 8 major codes
