ACADEMIC AFFAIRS ENHANCEMENT INITIATIVE

In the continued effort to support quality academics, the Office of the Provost is pleased to announce the Academic Affairs Enhancement initiative as part of the continued effort to support our faculty and staff. As stated by the President, this initiative is financed through Vision 2028 funding directed towards Academic Affairs. It is designed to facilitate opportunities for faculty and staff to develop and execute a bold vision to meet the goals of Vision 2028 and the University's Wildly Important Goals (WIGS):

- Enhance our appeal
- Enhance student success
- Develop our people.

In alignment with these criteria, the Office of the Provost intends to support projects that:

- Enhance the profile of the University
- Support faculty-student engagement
- Improve internal and external collaborations and outreach
- Maximize impact for the campus, its faculty and staff, and our students.

Some examples of possible projects are provided below but creativity is highly encouraged. Faculty should not feel limited to these.

- Piloting and reporting on new pedagogical tools and approaches
- Developing and piloting a 1-week summer camp for middle or high school students
- Professional Development opportunities to enhance leadership, pedagogical skills, and scholarly activities
- Develop and test new student success strategies
- Engage external groups (e.g DECA and FFA) who utilize the campus by developing content to showcase for participants what CSU Pueblo has to offer
- Reinvigorate student clubs and organizations
- Provide outreach activities that bring regional middle and high school students to campus.
- Promote faculty wellness and engagement.

Funding is available to support proposals from Faculty and Staff within Academic Affairs. Total initiative funding is \$600K. Scope of the budget of submitted proposals may range widely and all applications will require good justification of requested funds. Please not student travel will not be supported on these funds.

Applications accepted on a rolling basis and reviewed as received, contingent upon remaining funds.

Apr 10, 2023 at 5pm

Awardees will be notified of decision within one month after submission.
