### **Statement of Institutional Organizational Classification, Governing Board, and Accreditation**

Colorado State University – Pueblo is a public, state controlled institution of higher education. As a publicly funded institution of higher education the university is not a “for profit” institution. The university does not hold 501c3 status.

Colorado State University – Pueblo is part of the Colorado State University System (CSUS) and is governed by the Board of Governors of the CSU System.

The university is a predominantly undergraduate institution (PUI) that offers bachelorette degree programs (28) and a select number of master degree programs (8). The Carnegie Classification of CSU-Pueblo is, *Master’s I Small*, based upon its array of academic programs and current headcount enrollments.

Colorado State University – Pueblo also holds designation as a Hispanic Serving Institution (HSI) from the Federal Government due to its student population which is greater than 25% Hispanic.
