- Y A minimum of 60 semester hours must be earned from a four year institution. Of these, a minimum of 30 semester hours of credit must be earned in residence.
- Y Of the last 30 semester credits earned immediately preceding graduation, no more than 15 may be completed at other colleges or universities.
- Y All other requirements as specified in the Catalog.

- Y Complete an emphasis of study with a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher
- Y Earn a minimum grade of a "C" in all prerequisite and major courses
