

STUDENT EMPLOYEE AGREEMENT

As a degree-seeking student enrolled for at least 6 credits at Colorado State University-Pueblo and having accepted an employment position, I agree to abide by the following conditions:

- Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress as defined by the University's Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy
- 2. Maintain at least six (6) credits per period of enrollment for which I am employed.
- 3. Recognize that work-study is to be earned. Studying, reading, surfing the internet, etc. is prohibited during scheduled work hours.
- 4. Maintain a professional attitude in dress, speech, and habits.
- 5. Understand the importance of handling confidential information about the University, faculty, staff, or other students and all confidential information to which I have access must be protected.
- 6. Work no more than twenty (20) hours per week when school is in session and no more than thirty (30) hours per week when school is not in session.
- 7. Understand that I may only work with my supervisor's permission when regular University offices are closed such as weekends and holidays.
- 8. Understand that I may only work with my supervisor's permission if class is cancelled or ends early.
- 9. Submit an accurate timesheet for approval to my supervisor no later than 5:00 p.m. on the third working day of the month.
- 10. Coordinate a work schedule with my supervisor, using my class and personal schedules.
- 11. Assist my supervisor in monitoring my hours to prevent over-earning my work-study award amount.
- 12. Notify my supervisor no later than the first hour of the scheduled work period if I am going to be late or are unable to work my shift.
- 13. Understand that excessive tardiness or absenteeism may result in dismissal.
- 14. Understand that I cannot hold more than one (1) work-study position at a time.

All wages paid to student employees by the University, including those that are earned through the work-study program, are subject to federal and state income taxes and should be reported. Need-based work-study earnings may be excluded from income reported on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
