ABOUT STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

TRIO - Student Support Services purpose is to increase the retention and graduation rates of low income, first generation students and students with disabilities at Colorado State University-Pueblo .This is accomplished by providing supportive services such as: academic action planning, tutoring, and monitoring of student academic progress. Participants are eligible to utilize academic success seminars, mentoring, college success course, academic, financial and graduate school advisement.

To be eligible to receive services from TRIO - Student Support Services Project you must:

- Be enrolled or accepted for enrollment at CSU-Pueblo as an undergraduate student.
- Be a citizen, national or permanent resident of the United States.
- Be a low-income student as outlined by the Department of Education criteria; or,
- Be a first generation student; or,
- Be a student with a documented disability.
- Meet the academic need criteria as established by the CSU-Pueblo SSS Project.
