Colleagues,

Just over two years ago, the Board of Governors of the CSU System hired Dr. Timothy Mottet to lead CSU-Pueblo, knowing at the time that this campus had a rich history, a core position in the Colorado higher-education marketplace, and some tough challenges ahead. The Board tasked Tim with creating a bold new vision for CSU-Pueblo and establishing a comprehensive plan toward financial sustainability for the campus.

Last May, President Mottet launched Vision 2028, and over this past year, CSU-Pueblo successfully established a new vision and mission that puts the student experience and student success at the forefront. At this month's board meeting, President Mottet and his team presented an implementation plan for Vision 2028 — one that has the support of the students, faculty, staff, and community, and now the Board itself. We made significant strides toward fiscal sustainability with a lot of hard work and collaboration over the past two years, and now there is a vision in place for a more secure and prosperous future. On behalf of the CSU System, I want to thank President Mottet, his leadership team, and the entire campus community for laying the critical groundwork for Vision 2028 and its implementation.
