

ACADEMIC AFFAIRS ENHANCEMENT INITIATIVE 2022-23 Funding Summary (May 31, 2023)

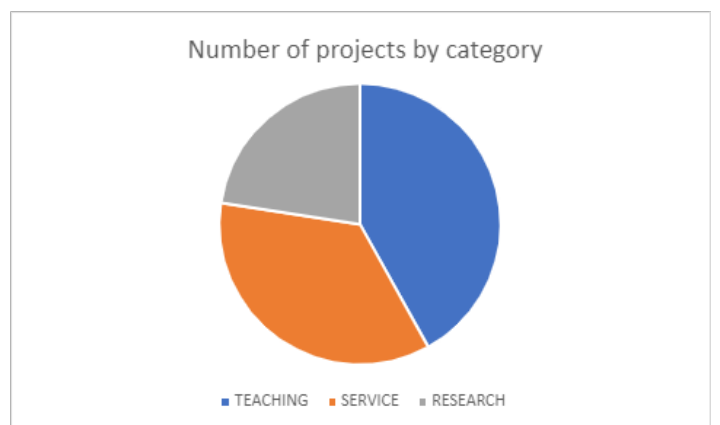
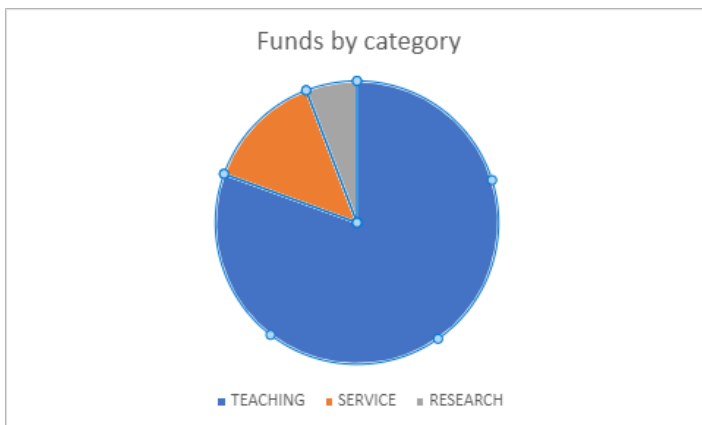
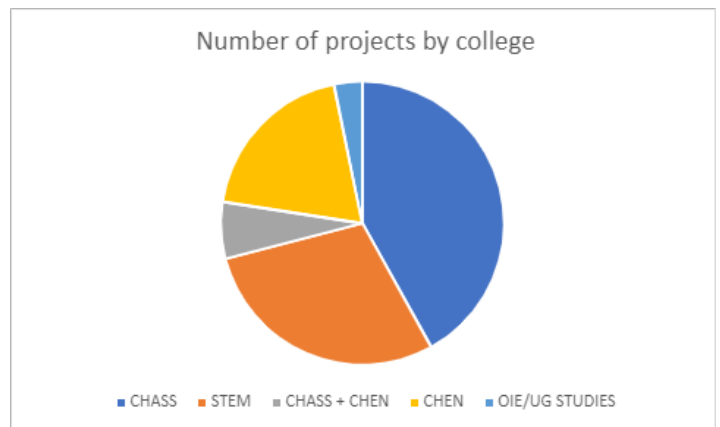
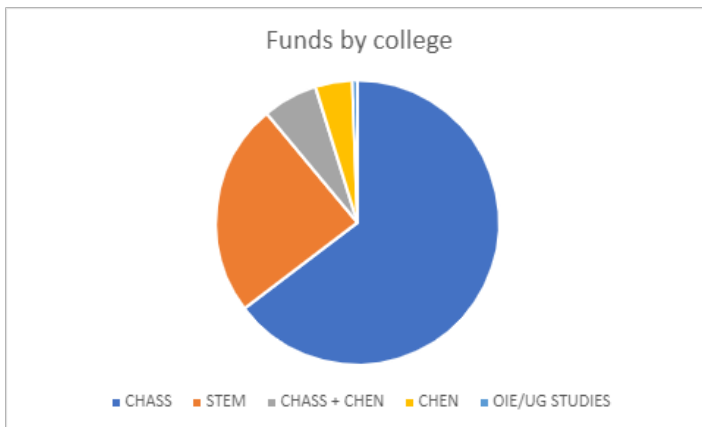
The Office of the Provost announced in fall 2022 the Academic Affairs Enhancement initiative which was financed through Vision 2028 funding directed towards Academic Affairs. It was designed to facilitate opportunities for faculty and staff to develop and execute a bold vision to meet the goals of Vision 2028 and the University's Wildly Important Goals (WIGS):

- Enhance our appeal
- Enhance student success
- Develop our people.

In alignment with these criteria, the Office of the Provost called for projects that would:

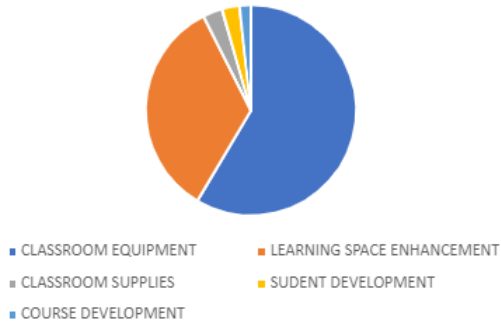
- Enhance the profile of the University

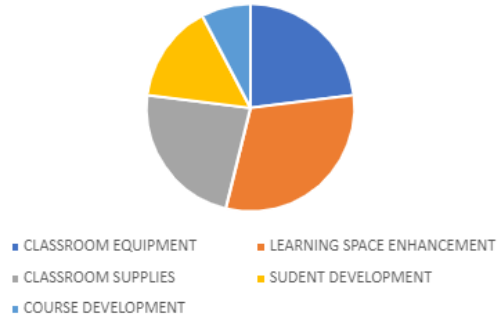

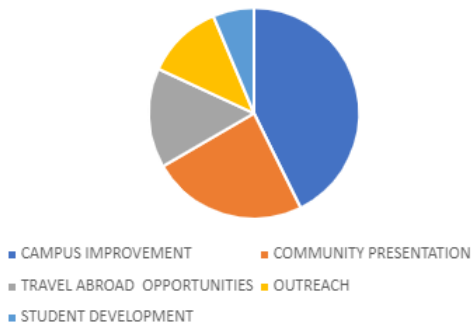
Funds for teaching projects



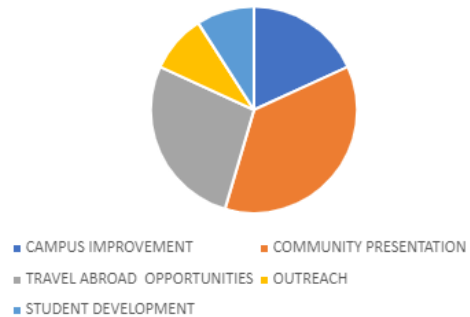
Number and type of teaching projects



Funds for service projects



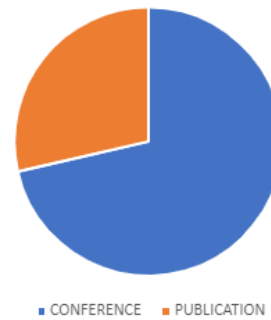
Number and types of service projects



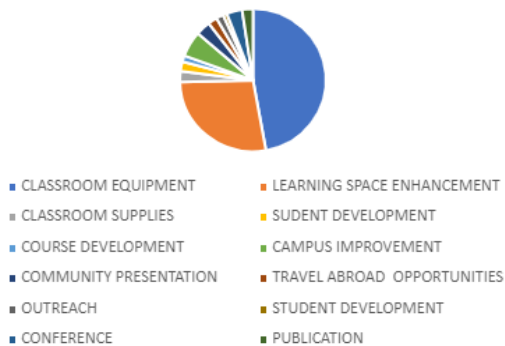
Funds for research projects
